

It cannot escape us that the holy places will be reduced to lifeless monuments if there is not a resident Christian community to care for them and to celebrate the sacred mysteries in them on a daily basis.

In order to support the Christian community and the sacred shrines in the Holy Land, the annual Good Friday Collection will be taken up again this year. The Good Friday Collection has received pontifical approval. It is applied directly and with utmost solicitude for the aid of the Christian community in the Land of the Lord.

The Good Friday Collection will be taken up on April 10, the day on which we celebrate Our Lord's Passion and Death. I ask you to contribute generously to the collection, which is so important for maintaining the Christian presence in the **Holy Land**.

Finally, pray that violence in the Holy Land ceases and that peace be given a chance.
